

**Announcement Text:****Pre-doc and Post-doc positions for sport psychology and motor learning/control at the German Sport University, Cologne, Germany are available April 2008**

Pre-doc and post-doc positions with Dr. Markus Raab are available at the German Sport University, Department of Psychology starting April 2008. A pre-doc position is for three years and post-doc positions are for two years and renewable on a biannual basis to a maximum of six years.

We are seeking two post-doc positions or three pre-doc positions, although other combinations of both full-time and part-time appointments will be considered. Many different projects are ongoing in the interdisciplinary environment and the successful applicant will have a variety of opportunities to work in research projects, as well as to pursue their own research as long the projects relate to ongoing lab activities. German fluency is neither a requirement for working at the German Sport University nor to enjoy daily life in Cologne, a vibrant city with a population of one million. The working language is English and minimal teaching in English or German is required (2-4 hours/week, depending on level, for each of two 15-week terms/year). Experience in designing experiments and analyzing data in the laboratory and/or field are preferred. Some experience with software and techniques for collecting and analyzing any of kinematic data, eye-movements, and electrophysiological data is a distinct plus. Experience with data collection among athletes of different expertise levels is also advantageous. Remuneration is about €17.000 (Euro) per year for doctoral students and about 25.400 (Euro) for post-doctoral appointments, before taxes. The post-doc candidate must be within 5 years of completion of their Ph.D., or be at the final stages of completing a Ph.D., in any field related to the study of (sport) psychology or motor learning/control. Applicants for all positions should send a CV, a statement of research interests, three representative publications (or less in case of pre-docs), and a letter of reference to the address below or as a pdf-package via email. Review of applications will start immediately, job talks are planned to take place late November or early December in Cologne and will continue until all positions are filled.
