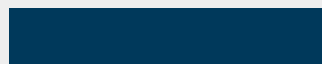
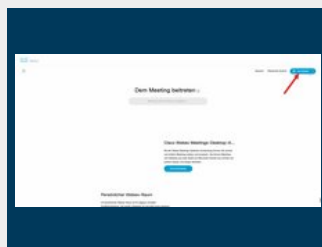
Three steps to start using Cisco Webex Meetings for web meetings:

1. Get your automated access email.
2. Click the activation link in the activation e-mail.
3. Open the uni-flensburg.webex.com homepage and START.

Note for first-time users!

Don't be surprised by the Webex log-in process:

In the first step, you must enter your e-mail address and then your normal [network login data](#). Depending on which browser you use, you may then see a data consent form. Simply confirm it by hitting "accept." This is a so-called Shibboleth-authentication.
