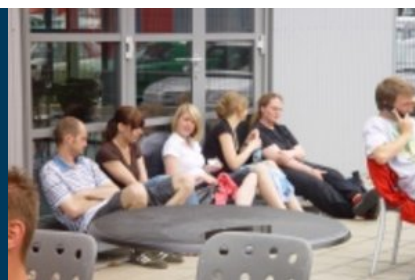

Overview of the degree courses

The partial degree program in engineering primarily prepares its graduates for a technical teacher's career at elementary, common or special needs schools. For this purpose, two courses of studies have to be completed, leading to the degrees "Bachelor of Arts" (6 semesters) and "Master of Education" (4 semesters). In each of such degree courses, the subject "Engineering" can be studied (Partial degree program in "Engineering").

"Engineering" as a partial degree program

Engineering can be studied as a partial degree program within the following courses of studies:
