The project aims at developing a regional heat atlas with a lean-data approach. It is being funded by EK.SH, the Energy and Climate research funding platform of Schleswig-Holstein with industrial partnership of Gottburg Energie- und Wärmetechnik GmbH & Co. KG.

## Heat Roadmap Europe 4

HRE4 aims to develop low-carbon heating and cooling strategies, called Heat Roadmaps, by quantifying and implementing changes at the national level for 14 EU Member States. HRE4 is funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under grant agreement No. 695989, and addresses topic EE-14-2015 "Removing market barriers to the uptake of efficient heating and cooling solutions" of the Energy-efficiency Call. EEM contributes with a further development of Peta, including detailed mapping of demands and supply, extensive data input for energy systems analysis and an online mapping platform.

## Stratego

The STRATEGO project (2014-2016) was a European co-funded project developed in the framework of the Intelligent Energy Europe Programme. The purpose of the project was to provide tangible support in developing National Heating and Cooling Plans; assist local authorities in evaluating their Heating and Cooling potential; find their priority area for intervention; and identify concrete projects that should be implemented. EEM contributed to Stratego with Peta, the Pan-European Thermal Atlas.
