### Bachelor Application

For Bachelor admission all applicants have to follow the online application procedure unless stated otherwise.

- › All applicants who do not have a German high school certificate require one of the following certificates as proof of German language skills. The English programs do not have this requirement.
  - › Bildungswissenschaften: Goethe-C2, DSH-3 or TestDaF at level 5 in all four test sections
  - › International Management: Goethe-B2, DSH-2 or TestDaF at level 4 in all four test sections
- › Applications must include officially certified copies of the high school certificate as well as an officially certified German or English translation.
- › Applicants are encouraged to hand in their certificates including translations as early as possible within the application period (May 15 to July 15). If verification is not possible at the University's admissions office the documents will have to be sent to the German central verification office in Bonn (ZAB). The verification process may take several months.
