Description

The Arabic A1.1 course is suitable for students without previous knowledge. It is primarily about teaching the first basic knowledge of the Arabic language.

On the basis of everyday conversation topics and situations (greeting and introduction; nationality and language; addresses and numbers) basic knowledge of Arabic grammar, vocabulary and writing should be taught. In the development of word fields, the following main topics are covered: Presentation of the person and introduction of persons (name, nationality, profession or study course, place of origin, family), hobbies and interests. The grammar focuses on Arabic letters, personal pronouns, possessive pronouns, question particles, question words and nominal sentences.
