### Description

The Italian language course A2.1 is aimed at all students who have a basic knowledge of the Italian language according to level A1 and would like to further develop and deepen this knowledge.

With a playful approach and activities, students will be able to practice communication in groups and individually, using the example of contextual situations and current topics of Italian culture, practicing vocabulary and grammatical structures.

The following communication goals are pursued in the course: to talk about people and things in the past, to express memories, desires, dreams and feelings, to give advice and ask for advice, to express criticism, to make predictions, to present and defend one's own opinion, to apply somewhere. The grammar focuses on: the conjugation of tenses in the indicative Passato Prossimo, Imperfetto and the modes Condizionale and Imperativ of regular and irregular verbs, possessive and relative pronouns, comparatives and superlatives.

The course takes place once a week. A final exam is written on the last day of the course.

In the course of the semester, course participants complete 30 attendance hours. Regular participation is a necessary prerequisite for successful learning. This includes an additional 30 hours of work for homework, own vocabulary work and the preparation of presentations and final exams.
