Students can specialize in one of the following main subjects:

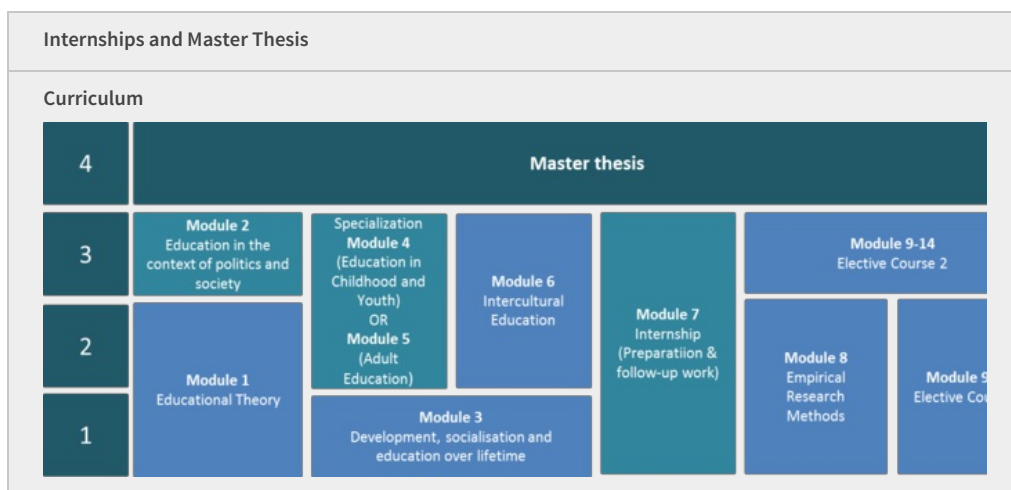
- › Education in Childhood and Youth
