Duties:

- To teach 2 semester hours per week (SWS)
- To support the collective research of the department
- To carry out an independent doctoral research project focused either on “Historical analysis of the development of experimental practice in the physical sciences” or on “Historical analysis of the development of experiment-based teaching”

Participation in international conferences to present interim results is strongly encouraged and will be appropriately funded.

Requirements:

- A solid (a minimum grade of “good”) university degree (Magister, Master or comparable) in physics, school physics for educators, or a physics-related field within the history of science
- Proficiency in English (level C1)
- Interest in interdisciplinary work
