**W3 Professorship for General Business Administration  
with a Focus on Finance and Accounting**

We are looking for an internationally visible person from the field of economics whose research and teaching centers on business finance and accounting areas, with a special focus on the sustainability-related aspects of the candidate's discipline (e.g., environmental controlling, sustainable finance, green finance, corporate social responsibility reporting, social and/or environmental accounting). The professorship is intended to contribute to the cross-institutional research focus on transformation and sustainability that is currently being established as a priority research area at Europa-Universität Flensburg.

In teaching, this professorship represents the fields of finance and accounting in their entire breadth. Duties include designing and covering the teaching needs of undergraduate courses in the subject areas of finance, controlling, and accounting for the EUF bachelor's degree program in International Management - Business Administration, the EUF master's program in International Management Studies- Business Administration and, if applicable, other interdisciplinary degree programs at Europa-Universität Flensburg. Courses are taught in German and English. The selected candidate is expected not only to be able to teach courses in English, but also to quickly learn German if he or she lacks German language skills.

Relevant academic qualifications and teaching experience in the field of finance and/or accounting with a focus on sustainability issues are expected. A degree in economics, a qualified doctorate in finance, plus additional academic achievements in the form of a habilitation, a successfully evaluated junior professorship, or the equivalent are all required. Sections 61-63 of the Higher Education Act of the State of Schleswig-Holstein shall further apply.

Experience in third-party fundraising is required. Proven university teaching skills, experience organizing academic events and projects, and the willingness to participate in one of the university's signature research centers and in the university's self-governing bodies are desirable.

Europa-Universität Flensburg strives to maintain a balanced gender ratio (m/f) in all employee status groups and seeks to further promote employee diversity with respect to the trajectories and competencies of its staff. Applications from persons with a migration background are

explicitly welcomed. Severely disabled applicants with adequate qualifications will be given preference.
