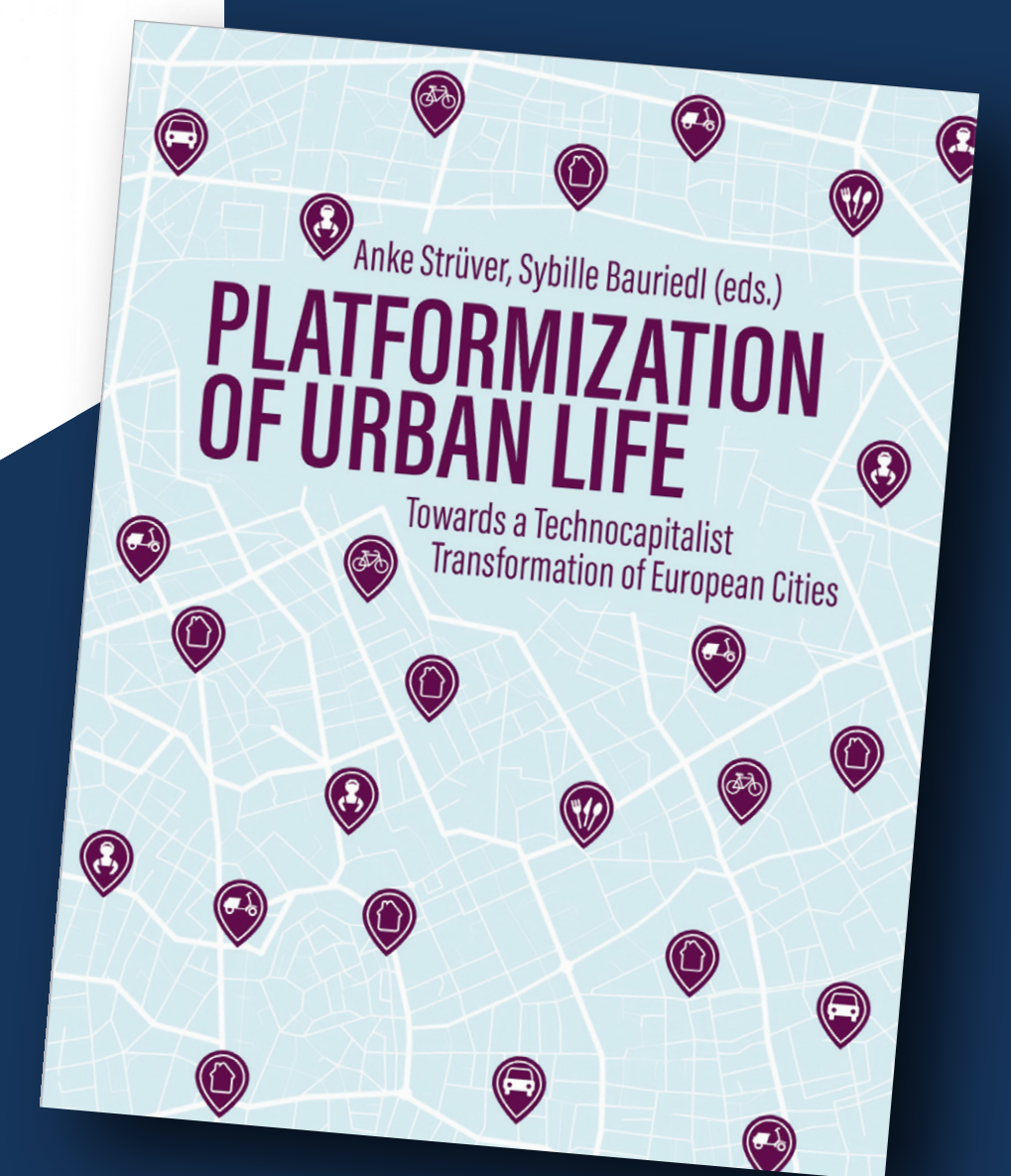




ICES PROJECT: Urban Platform Economies

**Transformations of labour and intersectional inequalities
in care services (TICS)**



The research project examines the structural conditions of care platforms and socio-spatial dynamics of care work with case studies in Hamburg, Vienna, and Zürich. For analysing socio-spatial effects of platform economies, mobile digital ethnographies are being used.

The objective is to contribute to the theorising of the new phenomenon of platform urbanism.

Research question: How does the rise of the digitally mediated care services in the platform economy transform everyday lives and inequalities in European cities?
