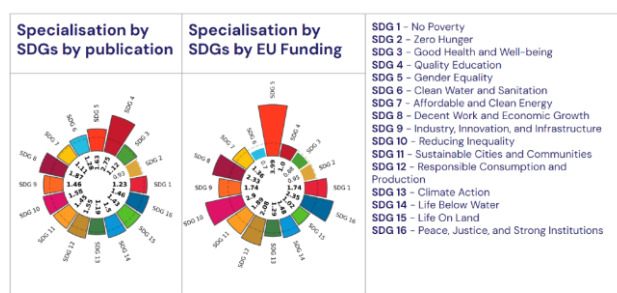


Figure 1: Specialisation by SDG by publication and EU-funded research compared to EU mean.
