Evaluation Criteria

Total: 100 + 10 bonus points

Minimum requirement: 60 + 10 bonus points

The purpose of the Call for Collaborative Projects is to address a local challenge or need through local implementation, while ensuring scalability across the alliance and sustainability in line with the three EMERGE values.

Each proposal will be reviewed using the following criteria. Sections 1, 5 & 6 are declarations only and are not scored.

Section 2: Proposal Summary (Max. 30 points | Minimum: 18 points)

Criteria	Description	Max Points
Motivation & Overview	Clear explanation of the idea and why it matters	5
EMERGE Value Link	Strong connection to at least one EMERGE value (2 points per value + 2 additional points for multilingualism & culture, and solidarity)	10
Target Group & Impact	Clear understanding of who benefits and thematic focus	10
Art, Education, Community Service & Innovation	Cohesive integration of one or more areas and unified project vision	5

Section 3: Challenge, Objectives & Implementation (Max. 40 points | Minimum: 24 points)

Criteria	Description	Max Points
Challenge Relevance	Addresses a real problem, need, or opportunity	10
Objectives	Clear, measurable, and realistic goals	10
Activities & Plan	Feasible steps, timeline, and implementation	15
Roles & Resources	Team responsibilities are clear; EMERGE resources utilised well	5

Section 4: Expected Results & Impact (Max. 30 points | Minimum: 18 points)

Criteria	Description	Max Points
Tangible Outputs	Expected results or products are clear	10
Impact on People	Clear benefit for students, staff, and/or community	10
Scalability	Potential to share or adapt across EMERGE alliance	10

Outstanding & Inclusive Idea and Impact	High creativity, originality, or inclusion potential	10
