Social and *Self-competence:* The students are able to acquire subject content both guided and independently; they are able to plan individual and group-based work processes sensibly and complete them in a timely manner; they deepen their ability to communicate subject content orally and in writing in a structured and methodically reflective manner and addressee-related manner; they deepen their ability to deal with conflict and criticism.
