Qualification Goal:	<p>The aim of the module is to teach the basics of comparative institutional analysis according to the particular needs of an international management course.</p> <p>This is done through the institutional configurations that serve and have served as regulatory frameworks for the activity of different times serve and have served as regulatory frameworks for the activities of companies.</p> <p>It is important that the students are taught the economic framework of international business activity. Particular emphasis is also placed on the students to learn to structure an empirical problem independently and to apply their theoretical knowledge to it. At the same time, the module serves as a basic course for the area studies. The lecture can therefore optionally be supplemented by the module Regional Economics I.</p>
Content description	<p>Institutional orders of the national economies of Europe are examined in an economic-historical perspective from the Industrial Revolution to the present. At the same time, theories are taught that explain the respective regulatory framework (theory of comparative cost advantages, corporatism, transaction costs, varieties of capitalism, etc.) and applied to past and present economic policy issues.</p> <p>The economic-historical approach serves to deepen understanding of the institutional heritage of European economies and a better understanding of their cultural differences.</p>
