Description

Academic German: Studying and Writing in German (C1/C2)

Target Group:

The language course "Scientific Writing" is suitable for students, doctoral candidates and international scientists with advanced knowledge who have successfully completed the C1.1 course or have achieved at least 203 points in the <u>placement test</u>. The course is also suitable for people whose first language is German.

Course Content:

In this course you will learn standards and rules of scientific writing, as well as techniques and linguistic devices for writing scientific texts. The focus is on writing a scientific term paper. You will get tips on planning and structuring the writing process, as well as revising your text.

Assessment: portfolio (70%), 2 short presentations (30%)
