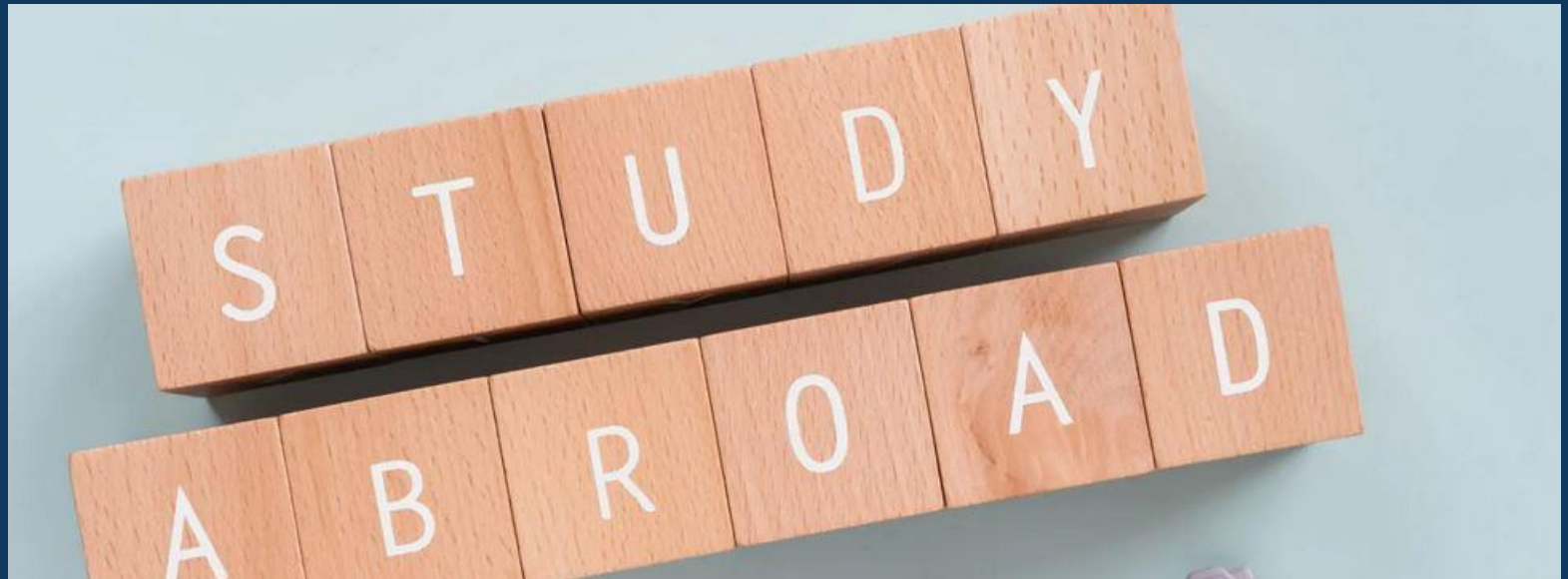

Step 1: Gather information about going abroad

Your first step is to get an overview: find out which countries worldwide are open to you for study, what are your options for doing an internship or shorter stay abroad, and how much time you should allow for planning.

Which universities can I attend during my stay abroad?

In principle, you can go to any university in the world as a "freemover." However, things will be easier for you in many ways if you visit one of EUF's over 100 partner universities.

■ **EUCS**

- You can already apply in the 1st semester in order to go abroad in the 4th semester (spring 2025)
- You can apply in the 3rd semester in order to go abroad in the 5th semester (fall 2024)

■ **EUS**

- Consciously consider whether you would like to go abroad
- You will be invited to our consultation hours once you get a place offer

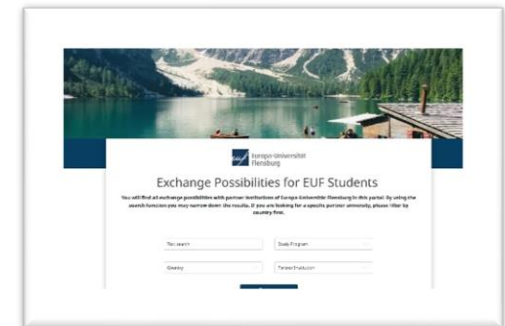
01 | Gather information

- **Where can I go to?**
- At a partner university the study programme has an agreement with
 - ✓ bilateral agreements with tuition waiver
 - ✓ in Europe: automatically registered for Erasmus+ (all countries in Europe except of Switzerland but including Norway and Turkey)
 - ✓ we have good contacts to the International Offices
- As a free mover you can choose any university: independent application



02 | Prepare: language

- At all universities you must have a B2 level of language of instruction
 - English: B2 at the time of application at EUF
 - Spanish, French, Portuguese: B1 at the time of application at EUF, B2 for the application at the partner university or before you leave
- check language courses at our Language Center (free of charge)



02 | Prepare: language

language of your chosen country; rather, it should be in the language in which you will be taking the majority of your courses.

You can choose from a wide range of free language courses at the EUF Language Center.

02 | Prepare: language

- English language proof: TOEFL ITP (paper-based English language test), 60€, responsible person: Mr. Scott Simpson

TOEFL ITP®

The TOEFL ITP® is a paper-based English language test. The TOEFL ITP® is not the TOEFL iBT®. The TOEFL ITP® tests receptive listening, grammar, vocabulary, and reading comprehension skills from A2 to C1 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages CEFR scale.

02 | Prepare: visa and vaccination

- Check visa regulations or requirements based on your individual status for the **time abroad** (destination) and also the regulations which apply once **you come back** to Europa Universität Flensburg (consider special regulations applying to e.g. refugee background, specific scholarship visa); register in time (have the deadlines in mind)
- Already ask the embassy of the country you would like to go about how to get a visa with *your* status
- Check the vaccinations if required

- ‚Auslandsbafög‘, student financial aid
- [DAAD \(Annual scholarship\)](#)
- student loans
- In Europe: Erasmus+ (except of Switzerland but including Norway and Turkey)
- Erasmus+ for Israel, Albania
- PROMOS for stays outside Europe

02 | Prepare: Financing

Erasmus+:

- European Mobility programme
- For mobility to partner universities with which an Erasmus+ contract exists
- Three different country groups and the monthly rate is paid according to the group (between 490 € and 600 € per month; funding duration and number of scholarships known by April 2024)
- Top-up funding (250€/month) for students with:
 - special needs (chronical illness that displays on your mobility which leads to higher costs abroad, degree of disability of 20)
 - with children (you only get the top-up once even for more children)
 - first academic person (if your parents do not have an academic degree)
 - working students (if you earned between 450-850€ 6 months prior to your application with us and the start of your mobility; thus in total approx.12 months)

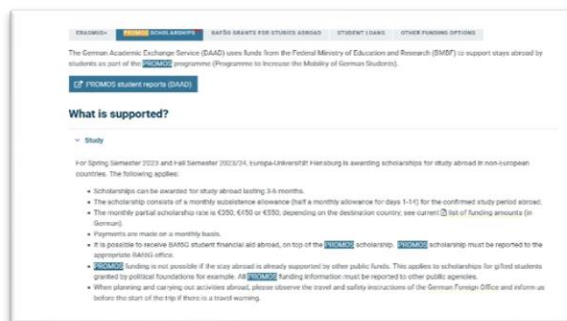
02 | Prepare: Financing

- Top-up for green traveling (50€) plus extra travel days
- All the information about Erasmus+: #41109
- You are signing a contract!
- You will get Erasmus+ mails
- You have to move!
- Special Erasmus+ funding for Albania, Israel (700€/month + travel allowance)

02 | Prepare: Financing

PROMOS

- Programme to Increase Student Mobility (DAAD & BMBWF)
- For stays to **non-European Countries**
- Apply online from mid-January until mid- March 2024
- Scholarships can be awarded for a period of 3-6 months
- Different funding amounts depending on the destination country (€350/450/550 per month)
- Aid application possible



02 | Prepare

The destination is up to you, but...


- Please consider that Erasmus+ is only paid by a fixed monthly rate and that the financial details will only be known in April 2024
- Please consider that living costs vary according to the destination (e.g. living costs in Norway are very high, in Poland lower)
- Please inform yourself about the legal possibility to work abroad (e.g. does your visa status allows it)

Thus, make sure that your financial situation fits to your choice!

Step 2: Apply to go abroad

Have you made up your mind to go abroad for a study semester, internship or language course? Then your next step is to apply!

If you want to do an internship, language course, or other shorter stay abroad, you'll need to arrange that on your own. However, for a semester abroad at a partner university, please apply through the International Center. This is always done a year before you intend to travel. During the multi-stage application process, you can select up to three preferred universities. The required application documents include proof of your proficiency in the language of instruction for your chosen country abroad.

Two step procedure:

1. Application to the International Office of EUF
2. Application to the partner university

1. Application to the International Office of EUF

Two separate application rounds for the semester abroad in the academic year 2024/25 (fall and spring)

1.a non-European partner universities: 30 Nov -12 December 2023

1.b Erasmus+ partner universities: 12 January – 25 January 2024

03 | Apply

1 a. Places at *non-European partner* universities: 30 November 2022 to 12 December 2022.

Before holidays you will receive an official place offer, which you have to accept or reject bindingly by 04 January 2024.

In January/February we are going to nominate you at your partner university.

February to June: Application to your partner university.

03 | Apply

1.b Places at our Erasmus+ partner universities (also Israel, Albania, Switzerland, Turkey, Norway): 12 January until 25 January 2024.

After approx. 4 weeks you will receive an official place offer, which you must accept or reject bindingly by 29th February 2024.

Important: If a place from the first application round has been accepted, it is not possible to apply in the second round!

In March we are going to nominate you at your partner university.

March-June: Application to your partner university.

- Chosen partner universities (up to three), EUS students within DD: only Catania
- Proof of language skills
- Transcript of Records (unstamped), EUCS 1st semester hand in a school leaving certificate with GPA, EUS students hand in Bachelor Diploma
- CV
- Letter of motivation (500-600 words)

- Contract
- Signed by you and me
- With the courses that you want to do abroad
- And the courses that you want recognized here
- To be signed before the mobility starts

Courses to complete in the semester abroad

- 30 ECTS
- Relatively free choice of courses
- What is allowed? → Connection to EUCS
 - Mixture of courses?
 - Specific courses abroad?
 - What do you want to study afterwards?
 - Maximum of 5 ECTS for a language course
- **Not allowed:** Yoga courses, sports courses, non academic courses

IMPORTANT: talk to me (email, office hours, schedule a meeting, etc.

- Ex. 4th sem. Specialization in Society = Research Methods II (10 ECTS) + in-depth soc. + Urban Dev. + Social Practice (15 ECTS) + Transnational Perspectives (5 ECTS)
- Ex. 5th sem. Specialization in Cultures = Autonomous Project (10 ECTS) + Science + Education + Languages (15 ECTS) + Sustainability (5 ECTS)

EUS: Dr. Laura Asarite-Schmidt

Recognition after return

- Application for recognition (jointly with the transcript of records) after return: no surprises at best, since everything has been arranged beforehand
- No registration with studipoint, credits and grades are transferred to studipoint after application
- Important: without Learning Agreement no guarantee that courses will be credited
