02 | Erasmus+ scholarship

- **Self-organized** internships abroad (**worldwide**)
- For **matriculated students and graduates**
(within the first 12 months of graduation; approval of application must be completed before the end of the studies/exmatriculation)
- Internship duration: min. 60 days
- Funding depending on destination country
- Top-ups for students with chronic illnesses, disabilities, child(ren), working students, first-time graduates (€250/month); travel expense allowance for non-European countries
- **Application at any time, at the latest 2 months before the start of the internship** – the earlier, the better

03 | DAAD scholarship “Kurzstipendien”

- **Self-organized** internships abroad with
 - German embassies, consulates, ...
 - international organizations (e.g. EU, UN, NATO, World Bank)
 - Goethe-Institut
 - Institutes of the Max Weber Foundation
 - selected institutions of foreign cultural policy
- For **matriculated students**
- Internship duration: 40 days - 3months (applicants must be matriculated during the entire internship period)
- **Application: 60 - 32 days before the start of the internship**

03 | DAAD scholarship “Carlo-Schmid-Programm”

- **Self-organized** internships abroad and **internships offered on program website**
 - international organizations
 - EU institutions
 - NGOs
- For **matriculated students and graduates with German citizenship**
- Internship duration: 4-8 months
- **Application: 1x/year** (for internships starting in September 2025: Dec 2024-Feb 2025)

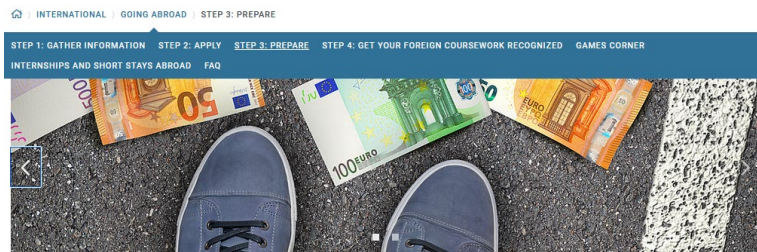

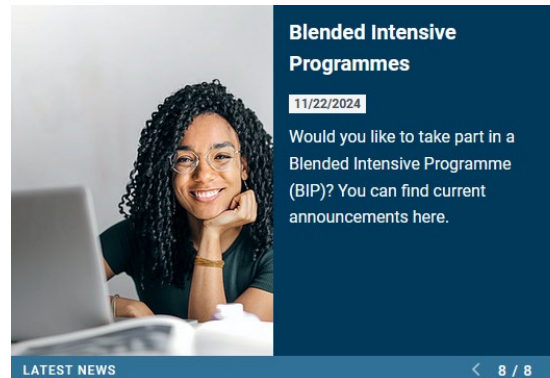
