02 Erasmus+ internship



- Self-organized internships in EU countries, Turkey, Norway, UK, Liechtenstein, Serbia,
 North Macedonia, Iceland
- For matriculated students and graduated students
 (within the first 12 months of graduation; approval of application must be completed before the end of the studies/exmatriculation)
- Current internship offers e.g. on https://erasmusintern.org/ and https://www.uni-flensburg.de/international
- Internship duration: min. 60 days
- Funding depending on destination country 640€-750€/month for 60, 90 or 120 days
- Top-ups for students with chronic illnesses, disabilities, child(ren), working students, first-time graduates (€250/month) and green travel (€50 + travel days)
- Application at any time, at the latest 2 months before the start of the internship the earlier, the better

03 PROMOS internship

- Self-organized internships outside Europe
- Not for internships that are eligible for funding through other DAAD programs
- For matriculated students
- Internship duration: at least 6 weeks
- Funding of €350, €450 or €550/month depending on the country
- Application for additional financial support possible for students with disabilities or chronic illnesses
- Application by January, 1 and June, 1 (with internship confirmation)
 As the funding for 2024 has already been exhausted, there will be no second application round on 1 June 2024

O4 DAAD scholarships ("Kurzstipendien") for internships



- Internships abroad with
 - German embassies, consulates, ...
 - international organizations (e.g. EU, UN, NATO, World Bank)
 - Goethe-Institut
 - Institutes of the Max Weber Foundation
 - selected institutions of foreign cultural policy
- For matriculated students
- Internship duration: 40 days 3months (applicants must be matriculated during the entire internship period)
- Application: 60-32 days before the start of the internship

04 DAAD scholarships for internships: "Carlo-Schmid-Programm"



- Self-organized internships and internships offered on program website
- Internships abroad with
 - international organizations
 - EU institutions
 - NGOs
- For german matriculated students and graduated students with German citizenship
- Internship duration: 4-6 or 4-8 months
- Application: 1x/year (Dec-Feb or Feb-Apr)




