How did you prepare for the semester abroad? What should
be organized in advance? Documents, Visa Application , Finance and Accommodation

Where did you live and how did you find your
accommodation (self-organized/provided by host
university, dormitory/private etc.)? I lived in a private dormitory. I took over someone else's contract. I found it on
facebook.

did you establish social contacts in other ways? Yes, the university organized activities for erasmus students such as dinner,
escape rooms, clay paintings, etc.

How satisfied were you with the host university (facilities,
staff etc.) and the course offer (workload etc.)? The teachers and administration is very good and encouraging for students.
Course work was justified and evaluation system was good.

Did you learn the local language? How important was the
language for your stay? I learned some basic phrases. The language was important for official work such
as immigration office and post office.

What intercultural experiences/skills have marked your
stay? Communication was definitely difficult for me due to the language and cultural
barrier.

Which perspectives on your host country/home country have changed - and why?	Wroclaw is a lovely city for students. I definitely have a better perception of Poland now.
How was your everyday life (leisure, shopping, transportation, inclusion etc.)?	There are numerous malls and the galeria and center is great as past time and for shopping. Eating out is also a great option here.
How did you manage financially? How much did you spend on visa (if applicable), travel, accommodation (per month), living expenses, leisure activities, other expenses (books etc.)?	Financially it was difficult due to the inflation due to war. First, had trouble getting an affordable accommodation and 330 Euros was not enough as my rent was 460 Euros. I did not get to travel or do leisure activities as much due to the financial restraints.
What was your best/worst experience? Is there anything else you would like to share?	There was no assistance for accommodation and Visa processing from either universities, which is very troubling for non-EU students. The financial aid should have been adjusted accordingly as there was not much price difference from Germany.
Would you recommend a semester abroad at your host university? For what reasons?	Yes, the host university is actually great. They did not overload us with coursework and course readings but was focused on projects and discussions.
