- **Additional application round:** for remaining places in March/April: you apply in your 2nd semester in order to study your 4th semester abroad

- **At all universities you will need a B2 level of language of instruction**
  - **English: B2 at the time of application**
  - **Spanish, French, Portuguese: B1 at the time of application, B2 when you leave**
- **check language courses at our Language Center (free of cost)**
- **If you are a native speaker you don't need a language proof**

- **In Europe: ERASMUS+ (except of Switzerland but including Norway and Turkey)**
- **ERASMUS+ in Albania, Israel, Palestine, Russia**

## 03 | Financing

- **ERASMUS+ in Europe:**
- **There are three different country groups and the monthly rate is paid according to the group (between 330€ and 450€)**
- **All the information about ERASMUS+: 26717**
- **You are signing a contract!**
- **You will get five ERASMUS+ mails**
- **You have to move (also if you study in Denmark)**
- **Special ERASMUS+ funding for Albania, Israel, Palastine and Russia**
  - Albania (700€ for 5 months; 275€ travel allowance)**
  - Israel (700€ for 3 months; 530€ travel allowance)**
  - Palestine (700€ for 3 months; 530€ travel allowance)**
  - Russia (700€ for 4 months; 275€ (Moscow) and 360 €(Penza) travel allowance)**

### Two step procedure:

1. Application at the International Office of EUF
2. Application at the partner university

### EUf:

You are applying at EUf using the link on our website. Documents to hand in:

- Your choice of partner university (up to three from the list of remaining places)
- Language proof
- Transcript of records
- CV
- Photo
- Statement of purpose (one letter for all three destinations)


**Deadline:**      **April 5th 2021 for your 4th (abroad)**  
                         **January 2022 for your 5th or 6th semester (abroad)**
