<p>After successfully completing the module, students will be able to work independently on research contexts in the field of international political economy. This is made possible on the basis of a well-founded overview of the relevant research literature in selected areas, whereby the central conceptual perspectives as well as the methodical and analytical tools associated with them are learned. Due to the strong interdisciplinary relation of the module, students also acquire competences in the field of interdisciplinary dialogue (ability to change perspectives, appreciation of the complementary strengths of approaches, ability to critically reflect their own disciplinary point of view).</p> <p>The module provides a well-founded and in selected areas in-depth overview of the relevant research literature on international political economy. In recent years, this discipline has been formed at the intersection of political science and economics and deals with the interactions between international politics and the international economy. It thus reacts to an increasingly globalized economy and politics. The seminar will discuss current research literature. Interdisciplinary references, especially between political science and economics, are a core component of the module.</p>
