Module title	<b>International Development</b>						
<p>The module helps students to develop a broad perspective on the history of human development against the background of which they can judge current development and predict future developments. The module also introduces students to the highly multi-disciplinary aspects of the field – e.g. overlaps between biology, history, agricultural science, genetics, economics, theology, politics, history of science and so on.</p> <p>Questions are pursued such as “why are white people rich and black people poor?”, “what is development and why do we develop?”, “why did Europe win?”, “what causes regional divergence?”, “what will happen in the future?”. Ethical and human rights aspects are looked at, such as emerging attitudes between racial groups and the conditions which development inflicts on working populations.</p>
