 - ✓ we have bilateral agreements with tuition waiver
 - ✓ in Europe: automatically registered for Erasmus+ (all countries in Europe except of Switzerland but including Norway, Turkey)
- As a free mover you can go wherever you wish to

- The **,normal' procedure** of applying for a semester abroad (3rd semester application → 5th or 6th semester at the partner university)
- **Additional application round**: for remaining places in April: in your 2nd semester you would apply for the 4th semester abroad
- if you are planning to go abroad in the 5th semester you apply according to the **,normal' procedure**

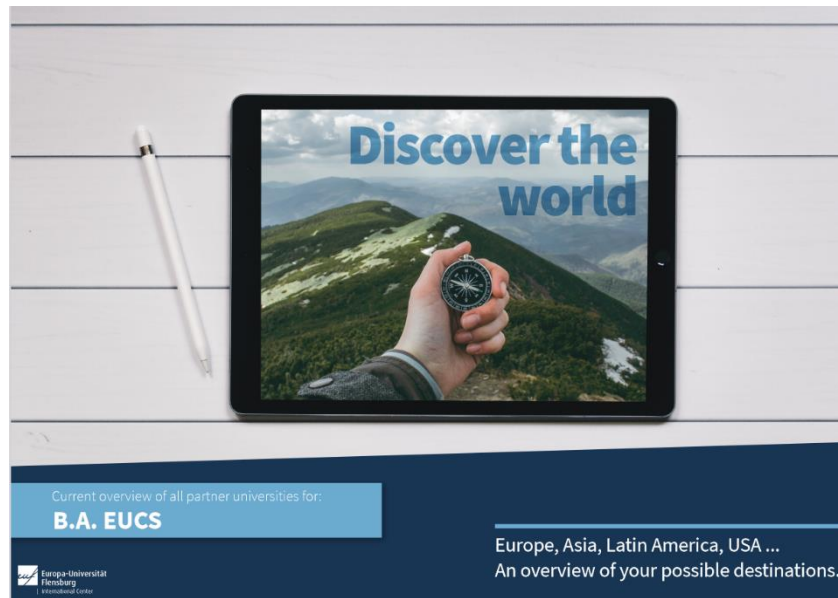

02 | Preparation- b. Language requirements

- **At all universities you will need a B2 level of language of instruction**
 - **English: B2 at the time of application**
 - **Spanish, French, Portuguese: B1 at the time of application, B2 when you leave**
- **check language courses at our Language Center (free of cost)**
- **If you are a native speaker you don't need language proof**

- Check visa requirements according to your **own/individual** status (refugee background, special study conditions)
- Already ask the embassy of the host country a visa requirements according to your status your status
- Check vaccinations if required

- **Auslandsbafög**
- **DAAD (Jahresstipendium)**
- **Bildungskredit**
- **In Europe: ERASMUS+ (except of Switzerland but including Norway and Turkey)**
- **ERASMUS+ for Israel, Palestine and Russia**

03 | Financing

- **ERASMUS+ in Europe:**
- **There are three different country groups and the monthly rate is paid according to the group (between 330€ and 450€)**
- **Top-up funding for students with special needs and/or with children**
- **All the information about ERASMUS+: 26717**
- **You are signing a contract!**
- **You will get five ERASMUS+ mails**
- **You have to move**
- **Special ERASMUS+ funding for Israel, Palestine and Russia**

Russia: 700 € per month for 4 months plus travel allowance (275€, 360€);

Israel, Palestine: 700 € for 3 months and 530€ travel allowance

04 | Application procedure

Two step procedure:

1. Application at the International Office of EUF
2. Application/Registration at the partner university

EUF:

You are applying at EUF online (website):

- Choice of partner universities (up to three)
- Language proof(s)
- Transcript of records
- CV
- Photo
- Statement of purpose (one letter for all three destinations)

Deadline: **April 2021 for your 4th abroad**
 January 2022 for your 5th or 6th semester abroad

04 | Application procedure

If you apply for the 4th semester abroad (spring term 2022)


Deadlines and things to consider:

- March: list of remaining places → will be sent to you by Patrícia Barbosa
- April: application deadline
- April/May: you get a place offer → **you** have to accept or reject
- September: nomination → **us**
- September-December: 2. **Application at the partner university** → **you**
- Before leaving: Learning Agreement → **you**

- **Application for recognition (jointly with the transcript of records) after return: no surprise at best, since everything has been arranged beforehand**
- **No registration with studiport, credits and grades are transferred to studiport after application**
- **Important: without Learning Agreement no guarantee that courses will be credited**

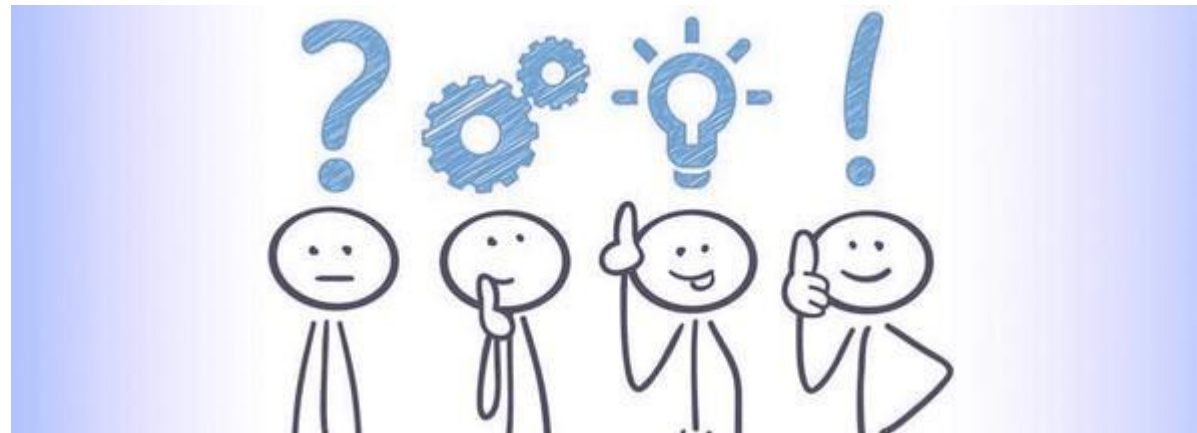
