- The EUF has more than 100 partner universities in 35 countries
- What does ‚partner university‘ mean:
  - ✓ we have bilateral agreements with tuition waiver
  - ✓ in Europe: automatically registered for Erasmus+ (all countries in Europe except of Switzerland but including Norway, Turkey)
  - ✓ we have good contacts to the International Offices
- As a free mover you can go wherever you wish to

- The **,normal' procedure** of applying for a semester abroad (3rd semester application → 5th /(6th) semester at the partner university)
- **Additional application round**: for remaining places in March/April
- **EUCS**
  - in the 2nd semester you would apply for the 4th semester abroad;
  - if you are planning to go out in the 5th semester you apply according to the **,normal' procedure**

## 02 | Preparation- a. choose a partner university

- **Wait for the list of remaining places (will be send to you in the middle of March)**
- **how to get to the website of the partner universities:**
- **Please check at this stage the *course catalogue***
- **Read the field reports of former outgoings**
- **Look at the website of the DAAD**





## **02 | Preparation- b. language requirements**

- **At all universities you will need a B2 level of language of instruction**
  - **English: B2 at the time of application**
  - **Spanish, French, Portuguese: B1 at the time of application, B2 when you leave**
- **check language courses at our Language Center (free of cost)**

- Check visa requirements according to your **own/individual** status
- Already ask the embassy of the country you would like to go about how to get a visa with your status
- Check the vaccinations if you wish to go to South America

- **DAAD (Jahresstipendium)**
- **Bildungskredit**
- **In Europe: ERASMUS+ (except of Switzerland but including Norway and Turkey)**
- **ERASMUS+ in Palestine and Russia**

## 03 | Financing

- **ERASMUS+ in Europe:**
- **BA has priority**
- **There are three different country groups and the monthly rate is paid according to the group (between 300€ and 420€ and you will get it for 3 or 3.5 months)**
- **All the information about ERASMUS+: 26717**
- **You are signing a contract!**
- **You will get six ERASMUS+ mails**
- **you have to move!**
- **special ERASMUS+ funding with Palestine and Russia (650€ per month for 4 month plus travel support (275€, 360€); 700€ for Palestine (3 months) 530€ travel costs**

## 04 | Application procedure

### Two step procedure:

1. Application at the International Office of the EUF
2. Application at the partner university

### 1. Start: 18th March 2019

You are applying at the International Office by handing in:

- Partner university (up to three)
- Language proof
- Transcript of records
- CV
- Photo
- Statement of purpose (one letter for all three destinations)



**Deadline: 5th of April or 22nd of April (according to the destination you apply to)**



## 04 | Application procedure

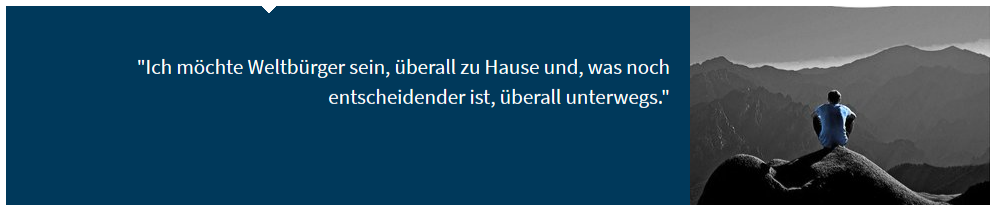
### What to do next?

- March: you get a list with the remaining places
- March 18th until April 5th/ 22nd: **you** may apply at our link
- April /May: you will get a place offer → **you** have to accept or reject
- April/ May: nomination → **we**
- September/October/November: **2. Application at the partner university** → **you**
- Before leaving: Learning Agreement → **you**

  - priority for Teacher Training: Sweden, Finland
  - own cooperation: Limerick, Bergen, Halden, Catania, Cyprus, Kielce
- **Spain, Portugal, Brazil**
  - Generally you study in the native language
- **France**
  - in Perpignan you have to study in French
- **Denmark**
  - you have to move!
