Our Fellowships

EMERGE Third-Places Research Fellowships allow senior researchers from any EMERGE university to engage with colleagues and local communities during a **one-month stay** within the EMERGE Alliance and its third places. The fellowships aim at enabling researchers to participate in research activities in diverse locations, possibly **involving new communities** or **participatory research** formats.

Application Procedure

A formless application, including

- your contact details and an abbreviated CV (max. 2 pages),
- a short description of your research project(s),
- a short description of the necessity for and details of the planned activities during your stay, including
 - a comment on the suitability of the chosen hosting institution(s),
 - a comment on in how far your stay aligns with the [EMERGE Alliance Values and Principles](#) and the Third-Places Research Fellowships,
- a preliminary time frame (the length of the fellowship must not be less than 25 days),
- an invitation letter from the hosting third-place for research within the Alliance.

Application documents must be compiled in one PDF file and sent via email to the EMERGE research coordinator at EUF, Dr. Isabella Tegethoff (isabella.tegethoff@uni-flensburg.de).

Third-Places for Research within the EMERGE Alliance

Our list of [third-places for research within the EMERGE Alliance](#) provides an overview of the designated institutions (research centres, laboratories, research hubs, technological platforms, innocampus, fablabs, living labs, co-working spaces, etc.) that have committed themselves to participating in the fellowship program. In addition, fellowships may possibly take place at any [research centre or research group across the EMERGE Alliance](#).

There is no entitlement to the availability of a fellowship place at a hosting institution, the acceptance of a fellow is subject to the capacity of the third-place.

Application Deadlines

25 January 2026

24 May 2026 (given the availability of remaining funds)

Scope of Funding

Fellowships are supported with up to 2500 EUR.

Settlement takes place in accordance with the Federal Travel Expenses Act (Bundesreisekostengesetz) as part of a business trip.

Reporting

Supported fellows are required to contribute to the social media coverage of their fellowship and to provide a short report on their fellowship experience (max. ¾ page).

Selection Criteria

A selecting committee at EUF will assess incoming applications with a special focus on the alignment of the fellowship with the [EMERGE Alliance Values and Principles](#) and the Third-Places Research Fellowships (see open call). The decision of the selecting committee may be affected by the need to maintain proportionality among different scientific fields and the balance between hosting and sending institutions.
