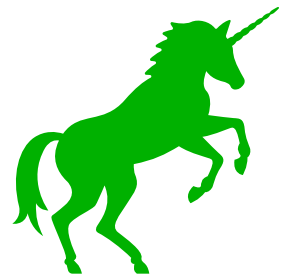
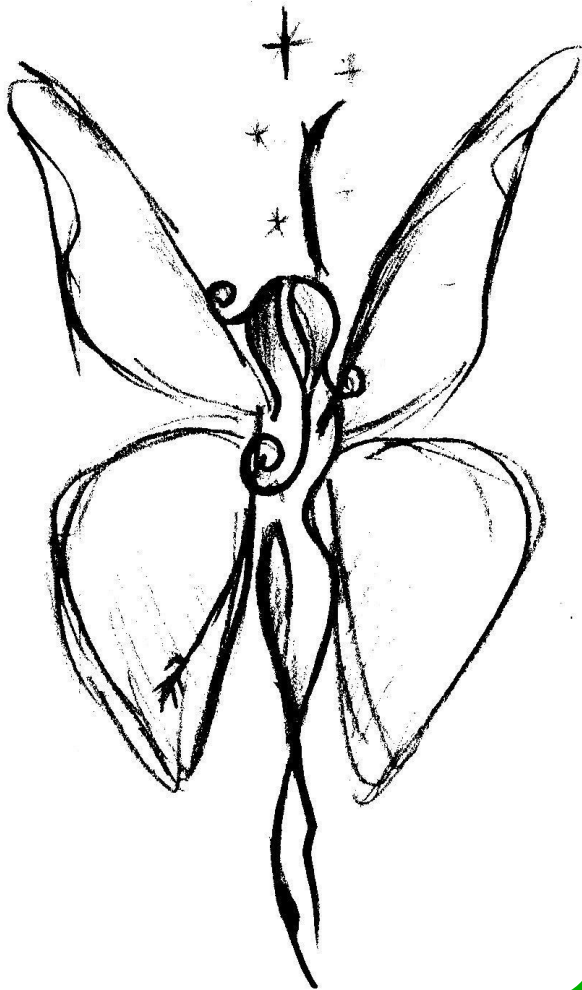


The Fairy tale School

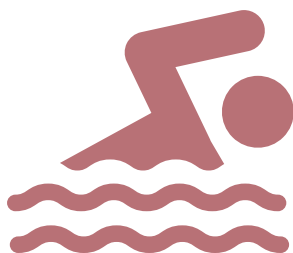
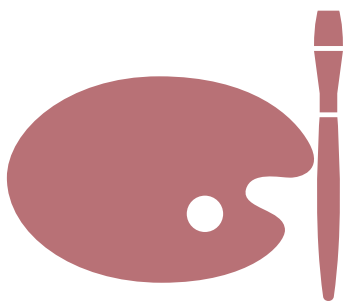

I lead several extra-cultural Activity, most of them are based on mental hygiene. It is a pleasure to see that the children here are open-minded for to discuss feelings and solve problems.



Our school system looks like...

-  *We use practical/active/physical and outdoor learning. If the weather is good, we hold the classes outdoors. The lessons are practical and interactive. Movement and play are also part of learning.*
-  *Important to us is also our psychological counseling. We listen to our students at any time. We help them not only in learning, but also in solving their mental problems. Their opinion matters and is important for us.*
-  *Playful mistakes. At Fairy Tale School we believe that mistakes are opportunities. In that sense, we teach our students how to deal with mistakes and solve them through games and artistic activities. External studies have shown that our pupils rank amongst the less frustrated students in Denmark and northern Germany.*
-  *Conflict solving and diversity. Authority is never the solution for appropriate behaviour. At our school, we offer courses on coaching and conflict solving to our students, which then can become official ambassadors and help their fellow students to solve their disputes in a peaceful and mature environment.*
-  *Smooth starter. We start each morning with a conversation. These sessions are 10-15 minutes. Teachers prefer that children to talk about feelings. What is he/she feeling, what's making them sad. Our goal is not for them to live each day the same way. We want to make them feel that: in the class and the school are their second home. Teachers are empathy-builders because they focus on*

teamwork, cooperation, caring, kindness, service and the importance of getting along with each other. Children learn to be responsible citizens, they learn how to improve their communities and how to contribute to societal issues.



Benefitting from teacher's talent. In our school every teacher has a special talent. And we use it! We don't use ordinary methods. Teachers weave critical thinking, planning, organising and problem solving into their teaching and that means pushing pupils out of their comfort zones so they see and experience the world differently.

Some of our colleagues, next to teaching, have our own passion. Most of us have studied music, play some kind of instrument, speak several languages or even work as master chefs as a second job. With these extra skills, we can develop the children in our afternoon programs .

We believe in modern methodologies and updated curriculums. In that sense, our teaching team is formed by interns and young teachers which are able to bring the most recent knowledge to our students. Besides that, we have regular research visits from professional pedagogies which carry out their investigations at our school and point out our gaps and strengths. 2 rest rooms for relaxation between classes

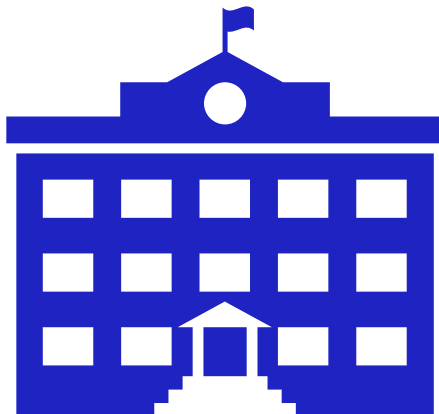
1 dining hall where students can have access to healthy food
