## **Getting to Flensburg**

Welcome to Germany! Let's take a quick look at how you can easily get from **Hamburg (station or airport)** to **Flensburg**, the northernmost city in Germany!





If you wish to reach Flensburg by train, you can take the S1 (S-Bahn) from Hamburg airport to Hamburg Hbf (central station).

From there you can take the train to Flensburg. *Travel time: approx. 140 minutes.* You might have to change trains, so remember to pay attention to the travel details. Tickets are available at every station at vending machines or in the Deutsche Bahn information points in main stations. You can also check timetables and buy tickets on the Deutsche Bahn website (bahn.com) or the DB Navigator app.





The main long-distance bus operator in Germany is Flixbus. Buses depart daily both from Hamburg airport (Terminal 1) and from Hamburg's main bus station (Hamburg ZOB, 5 minutes walk from the central station) and arrive at Flensburg train station.

Travel time: approx. 160-180 minutes.

You can check the timetable and buy tickets on the Flixbus website (<u>flixbus.com</u>) or the Flixbus app. We advise you to buy tickets beforehand to avoid extra costs (tickets bought from the driver have higher prices).

## Flensburg station. Now what?

Once arrived in the train station in Flensburg, you can easily reach the university campus and the student dorms by bus (Bus 4 or 5, "Flensburg Hochschule/FH" bus stop) or on foot (15 minutes walk). If you're already in contact with a student helper, have them meet you outside the station.
