

## **Teaching material-Tasmanian Devil**

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**Grade:** primary school

**Quality management:** Prof. Dr. Carsten Hobohm, Institute of Biology and Didactics,  
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**Material:** information and exercises

**Goal:** focusing on the Tasmanian devil, knowledge about the dangers it faces and ways of protecting it

### **Procedure:**

- Introduction: picture of the Tasmanian devil and globe/map to show Tasmania  
Teacher informs pupil about the biotope
- Complete the worksheet

### **Support for teachers relating to introduction**

- The teacher explains the biotope of the Tasmanian devil and that it is a beast of prey. The words “beast of prey“, “nocturnal“ and living in an “underground cave“ should be explained.
- If the teacher shows some native animals with the same features, it’s easier for the pupils to understand. In Germany a teacher could show the badger, for example.
