Teaching material-Tasmanian Devil

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Material: information and exercises

Goal: focusing on the Tasmanian devil, knowledge about the dangers it faces and ways of

protecting it

Procedure:

- Introduction: picture of the Tasmanian devil and globe/map to show Tasmania

 Teacher informs pupil about the biotope
- Complete the worksheet

Support for teachers relating to introduction

- The teacher explains the biotope of the Tasmanian devil and that it is a beast of prey. The words "beast of prey", "nocturnal" and living in an "underground cave" should be explained.
- If the teacher shows some native animals with the same features, it's easier for the pupils to understand. In Germany a teacher could show the badger, for example.
