Questions to the children

- 1. What does GEH mean? (Home page)
- What are the jobs of the GEH? (Menu button "The Society for the Conservation of old and endangered Breeds of Farm Animals (GEH)" and button "The AEU – Decree and Funding by the Federal States")
- 3. What is the aim of the GEH? (Also button "The Society for the Conservation...")
- 4. What is a "red list"? (internet research)
- Have a look at the breed of the year 2006, the German saddleback. Summarize the information about the pig. (worksheet "The endangered breed of the year 2006 The German saddleback")
- 6. Find out if there are any old and endangered livestock breeds in your country. Write them down. (internet research)
- 7. Make an inquiry about the sponsorships. Decide in the whole group whether you can help the GEH actively with the conservation of a breed, by taking on a sponsorship for an animal.
