

Call for Applications: Scholar in Residence

The European Wasatia Graduate School for Peace and Conflict Resolution at the European University Flensburg invites applications for its "Scholar in Residence" program. We welcome applications from senior scholars in fields such as political science, conflict and peace studies, theology, sociology, philosophy, or related disciplines.

The Graduate School hosts a diverse, international cohort of doctoral researchers dedicated to advancing interdisciplinary research on political reconciliation, transtional justice, conflict resolution and intercultural dialogue—particularly in divided and post-conflict societies.

Residency Details

- Duration: Minimum of 3 weeks in Flensburg (to be scheduled during the academic semester)
- Funding: A stipend of €3.000 is provided to contribute to related expenses (travel, accommodation, meals, and local costs)

Scholar's Role

- Supervise and mentor PhD students on their dissertation projects
- Deliver at least one public lecture in your area of expertise
- Conduct an in-depth seminar or workshop for doctoral researchers
- Participate actively in the academic and intercultural life of the Graduate School

Research Focus During the Residency

Scholars are encouraged to pursue their own research during the residency, aligned with the Graduate School's core themes, including:

- Peace and conflict resolution
- Reconciliation in post-conflict societies
- Religion, identity, and intercultural dialogue
- Democracy, justice, and pluralism
- Middle Eastern or European political and social thought

Collaborative projects with EUF faculty and contributions to ongoing Graduate School initiatives are highly encouraged.

Eligibility

- A completed PhD and/or current professorial appointment
- A strong academic record and relevant research profile
- Demonstrated commitment to mentoring and international academic exchange

Application Requirements

- Curriculum Vitae (CV) detailing academic background and publications
- Letter of Motivation (1–2 pages) explaining your interest in the program, how your research aligns with the Graduate School, and what you aim to contribute.
