PANELISTS



SIMON MIRAKAJ

Was born in Shkodër, in a family that was exiled from 1945 until the fall of the communist regime. He himself grew up in exile, from which he was released together with his family only in 1989.

He graduated from Faculty of Law, University of Tirana, and then the Academy of Public Order. Miraka served as an inspector of the Archives of the Ministry of Interior Affairs with the rank of Major and was later appointed Director General of the Institute of Former Political Persecutors, a position he held from 2002 until November 2013. From 2016-2022, Mr. Mirakaj is a Member of the Authority for Information on Former State Security Documents.



ASSOC. PROF. DR. LISEN BASHKURTI

Is the President of Albanian Diplomatic Academy. He is an honorary professor in many prestigious European Universities and an honorary fellow to a number of prominent international institutions.

He is a recipient of many international awards, including "Gold Medal" for his research on U.S.-Albanian Partnership," "Four Silver Medals" for his great contribution during his service as Albania's Ambassador to Hungary (1992-1993). He is the author of more than 18 books that cover a range of issues including International Affairs, Negotiations and Conflict Resolution, International Diplomacy, Multilateral Diplomacy and Diplomatic History.



FLUTURA AÇKA

Is a poet and writer. She holds two university degrees, from the Faculty of Economics, Tirana University in 1988 and department of Language & Literature, University of Elbasan in 2001.

After her first university studies, she worked for several years as an Economist and Auditor in the Company Collection Processing Elbasan (1988-1992). She also worked as a journalist and then as an administrator and editor of publications in "ONUFRI" Publishing House (1993-1998), "Fjala e Lire" Newspaper (1992-1993) and the Skanderbeg Books" Publishing House (2021 onwards). In 1997, she received the international prize "Lira e Struga" at the Struga Poetry Nights where she has represented Albanian poetry for several years. In 1998, she was chosen among the 13 best European poets of the new generation in the competition for the Tivoli-Europa grand prize in Italy. She is represented with her poems in most of the anthologies of Albanian poetry in foreign languages and her poems and cycles have been published in many languages. Currently, she is member of the Parliament from the Democratic Party.



JETNOR KASMI

Holds a Political Science degree with emphasis in International Relations from Methodist University, USA; and MA degree in Development Policy from KDI School of Public Policy and Management, South Korea. Originally from Tirana, Albania, Jetnor attended the United World College in Norway.

At Methodist University, he co-founded the university's chapter of Amnesty International, worked as a research assistant and History teaching assistant, and tutored students in History, Italian, and Spanish. Jetnor is interested in cultural conflict, Chinese foreign policy, and local government decentralization. Jetnor has published a paper regarding the Romany rights in the Balkan region, and policy analysis regarding the South Korean politics. Papers under publication include policy analysis regarding the Belt and Road Initiative in the Balkan Region.
