Authors may submit any time. Empirical, theoretical and conceptual texts of significant originality will be considered for publication. CPE welcomes submissions of original research papers, but also invites submission of essays, speeches, conference and research reports, and commentaries. All methodological approaches are welcomed. CPE publishes at least biannually.
