European Cultures and Society (EUCS)

Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)

The 1st and the 2nd semesters prepare you to study at university level. The main idea is to introduce everyone to the basics of this program. This allows you to choose where you want to set your focus in higher semesters – European Cultures or Society.

There is also an introduction to how to think in academic terms - how to ask questions and how to build logical answers. You also have the time to learn a foreign language and start gathering information for the semester abroad.

From the 3rd semester onward, you get to choose your focus: either European Cultures or Society, but not in an excluding way. Now you go deeper into the topics and start getting an idea of the details.

Alongside the topics you choose, you will learn through hands-on projects, so you get to use what you study in real-life situations. You can pick projects in the areas that excite you the most: visual art, university research, journalism, or business. Classes will be more interactive, as you get to discuss different topics in class to come to common conclusions.

Use the 4th or the 5th for the semester abroad. You have almost 90 partner universities on offer. If that is not enough, you are free to decide to go anywhere else. This is an amazing chance to explore the world.

The 6th and last semester is dedicated to writing your thesis. For that, you get the support of an instructor and weekly meetings with your classmates. You will also have your last discussions in class about current events.

At the end, get ready for the graduation ceremony.
