Pre-Doc Funding opportunities

Students/Doctoral Students at Risk Hilde Domin Programme (DAAD)

Hilde Domin Programme | Scholars at Risk

Type of funding: scholarship (861 € p.m. students; 1.200 € p.m. doctoral candidates)

Target group:

- students and doctoral candidates at risk from all disciplines (apart from human medicine, dentistry and veterinary medicine)
- Students and doctoral candidates with refugee status

Project duration: bachelors/masters degree: 48/24 months; doctoral degree: 48 months

Requirements

- proven or credibly demonstration of a threat to personal well-being or safety
- possession of educational certificates that enable entrance to a higher education institution and warrant the pursuit of a desired higher education qualification according to the anabin database.
- country of residence outside Germany and outside the EU at the time of nomination.

Hilde Domin Programme | Deadlines

Nominations can be submitted online **at any time.**

In principle, there are two selections per year.

- Nomination for start in spring semester 2025: until 15 March 2024
- Nomination for start in winter semester 2025: until 15 September 2024

DFG: Walter Benjamin Program for refugee scientists

- Type of Funding: Post-Doc positions at a German research institution
- Project duration: up to 24 months
- Who is funded
 - Post-Docs from all disciplines and without restrictions regarding the topic
 - open to refugee researchers at any stage of their career (usually only for early stage of Post-Doc career)
- Requirements
 - individual agreement in advance with a research personality at the host institution
 - Being a recognized refugee researcher
 - Having been outside home country for less than 3 years
- Deadline: Proposals may be submitted at any time.

Philipp Schwartz Initiative

(Alexander von Humboldt Foundation)

Philipp Schwartz Initiative | AvH

Type of funding: research fellowship or employment contract on post doc-level

Target group:

- researcher at risk from all disciplines (doctorate or comparable academic degree)

Project duration: up to 24 months; an extension of up to 12 months within a co-financing model is possible.

Requirements

- a residence status in the context of an asylum procedure within the EU showing a recognised threat, or credible evidence of risk from a third party
- having been outside home country for less than 5 years.

Deadline: next application period: 01/2024

Next application round will probably start in January 2024.

Integration in current funding programmes (DFG)

- Integration of qualified refugees in running DFG projects.
- A supplemental proposal can be geared towards any type of funding that enables refugees to be integrated in a project, in particular **guest funds, staff positions and the Mercator module**.
- Refugee researchers can also be funded directly as part of **Research Training Groups, Collaborative Research Centres and other DFG-funded joint projects** (without additional application).

GEPRIS – German Project Information System

- The GEPRIS Information System provides an overview of DFG-funded scientific projects as well as the researchers involved and their institutions.
- GEPRIS Data base

Application procedure:

- Proposals may be submitted informally **at any time** and should not exceed five pages.
- The proposals must include information on the individuals to be incorporated in a project and justify the added value provided by their involvement.

- psychological counseling either is given through ProRef
- Dedicated **counselling and recognition office** for international and refugee students and staff members
- Since 2020, part of the **Scholars at Risk Network (SAR)**; are in **regular exchange with regional actors** such as the Integration Office and the Coordination Office for Integration and Participation of the City of Flensburg.
- **Centre for Languages** offers a broad range of language classes
- **EUf Family Service** offers comprehensive services for scholars at risk with family responsibilities
- Centre for Academic Continuing Education (**ZWW**) offers interdisciplinary qualification opportunities
