# Two DFG-supported conferences on "Emmy Hennings" and "Purity in Minoritised Languages" DFG fördert zwei Tagungen an der EUF im Juni 2025

We are delighted to share that the DFG is funding two international conferences at Europa-Universität Flensburg in June 2025. From 12–13 June, a conference dedicated to the *author Emmy Hennings* hosted by Margot Brink (EUF, Professor of French Literature and Cultural Studies in a European context) will take place in Flensburg. On the occasion of her 140th birthday, the event will, for the first time, focus exclusively on Hennings' literary work and life concepts from an explicitly international perspective. Scholars from Ireland, Italy, Switzerland, Spain, the USA, and Germany will contribute new impulses to Emmy Hennings research. One week later, from 19–21 June, Prof. Dr. Nils Langer (EUF, Institute for Frisian Studies and Minority Research) will host the international conference *Purity in Minoritised Languages*, organized by in collaboration with researchers from Bolzano, Göteborg, and Texas. The event examines the role of linguistic purity and normativity in the sociolinguistic treatment and political positioning of minoritized languages. Internationale Tagungen "Comparative Perspectives on Taxation and the Colonial State" &
"Society and Law – Changing European Narratives"

It is a great pleasure to announce that the Fritz Thyssen Foundation is funding two international conferences taking place at Europa-Universität Flensburg in autumn 2025. From 25–27 September, the international conference *Comparative Perspectives on Taxation and the Colonial State* will examine fiscal governance in colonial contexts. Organized by Prof. Dr. Marc Buggeln and Dr. Jan Kreutz (both EUF, Forschungsstelle für regionale Zeitgeschichte und Public History), the event is linked to the DFG-funded and ICES affiliated project on taxation and state formation in German colonies and will bring together scholars working on colonialism and public finance (More information). One month later, from 22–24 October, the conference *Society and Law – Changing European Narratives* will take place, organized by Monika Eigmüller (EUF, Sociology), Anne Reichold (EUF, Philosophy) and Anna-Katharina Mangold (EUF, European Law). This interdisciplinary event explores how ideas of society and law have evolved in contemporary European discourse.

EU: Draft of Horizon Europe Work Programme 2025 published

# Vorabversion des Horizon Europe Arbeitsprogramms 2025 einsehbar – wichtige Themen für Kultur und Gesellschaft

The European Commission has published a preliminary version of the Horizon Europe Work Programme 2025, along with revised versions of the 2023–2025 programme documents. Final adoption is expected in May 2025. Of particular interest to researchers in European Studies might be topics included in Cluster 2 *Culture, Creativity and Inclusive Society*, which includes the following destinations: 1. Innovative Research on Democracy and Governance; 2. Innovative Research on European Cultural Heritage and Cultural and Creative Industries; 3. Innovative Research on Social and Economic Transformations. Researchers are encouraged to consult the draft documents early to prepare for upcoming calls. #### EU: New European Bauhaus Facility launched / Calls expected April 2025

Neues Förderinstrument zur nachhaltigen und inklusiven Quartiersentwicklung

The European Commission has launched the *New European Bauhaus Facility 2025–2027*, a Horizon Europe-based programme with a total budget of €120 million. The initiative supports research and innovation projects that integrate sustainability, inclusion, and aesthetics in the transformation of urban and regional environments. The facility also includes a roll-out component to scale up successful pilot solutions and enhance their societal impact. Around 500 local NEB projects have already been initiated. #### Interreg Baltic Sea Region: Third call for small projects / Deadline: 05.06.25

Neue Fördermöglichkeit für kleinere Projekte und Interreg Programmneulinge

On 25 March 2025, the Interreg Baltic Sea Region Programme opened its third call for small-scale projects. Project ideas must be submitted using the *Project Idea Form* by **5 June 2025** in order to be eligible for a full proposal by **8 October 2025**. The call particularly targets newcomers to the programme and supports initiatives aiming to improve quality of life, resilience, disaster preparedness, or access to public services in structurally weaker, smaller, or rural areas. Projects can receive up to €500,000 for a 2-year duration and benefit from simplified administration. ## DFG: International Cooperation – Standing Open Proposal Submission in Individual Grants Programme / No Deadline

DFG-Förderung für transnationale Forschungsprojekte mit europäischen und internationalen Partnern

The German Research Foundation (DFG) supports transnational research collaboration through agreements with multiple funding organizations in Europe and worldwide. In addition to fixed-deadline calls, some agreements allow for **Standing Open Procedures**, where proposals can be submitted at any time. **European** partners include Austria (FWF), Belgium (FWO, F.R.S.-FNRS), Czech Republic (GACR), Luxembourg (FNR), Poland (NCN), and Switzerland (SNSF), with a bilateral Lead Agency agreement in South Tyrol (Italy). **Worldwide**, the DFG cooperates with Brazil (FAPESP), Colombia (UNIANDES, UdeA), India (ICSSR), Turkey (TÜBITAK), and the USA (NSF in selected fields). Applications follow parallel submission procedures, with evaluations conducted independently by both funding agencies. Funding is granted only to proposals positively reviewed by both sides. Funding is provided for up to five years to develop new perspectives on democratic transformation and resilience. Transdisciplinarity is a central requirement: all partners are to be equally involved in shaping the research process from start to finish. ### Alliance of Science Organisations' statement on the new federal government's coalition agreement

Wissenschaftsallianz begrüßt Koalitionsvertrag – auch Geistes- und Sozialwissenschaften im Fokus

In a statement released on 14 April 2025, the Alliance of Science Organisations in Germany expressed strong support for the coalition agreement between CDU/CSU and SPD, highlighting its clear commitment to strengthening Germany as a location for research and innovation.

The Alliance particularly welcomes planned investments in research infrastructure, the reduction of bureaucracy, and the goal of raising R&D spending to 3.5% of GDP. It also emphasizes the importance of bundling funding across the research spectrum – from basic research to application. Notably, the agreement explicitly identifies not only health, climate, security, and marine research but also the humanities and social sciences as strategic research areas.
