ICES Call for field research and qualification grants / Deadline: 15.06.2025 ICES (ko-)finanziert Teilnahme an Methodenschulungen, Feldforschungs- und Archivaufenthalte

We provide grants for researchers in qualification phases at EUF as well as for associated ICES members who plan to conduct field research or archive/library stays. In addition, you can apply for funding to participate in European Studies-specific training courses. We can fund stays for research or qualification purposes of generally up to 1.200 euros each. They should take place in spring semester 2025 or autumn semester 2025/26. Please provide an application (max. 1 page), including a short description of your research project respectively the training program you plan to attend, the necessity for and details about your intended stay, preliminary timeframe, and a budget plan. Applications can be submitted in German or English. We give priority to ICES Research School members when awarding the grants. Please send it to ices@uniflensburg.de by 15.06.2025. The call is published every year in May and November. You can also apply for funding between calls. Applications will then be approved as part of the next call. We look forward to receiving your proposal.

Intimacy on the Move. Bodies, Economies & Desires across the Long 20th Century / Termin: 07.– 08.07.2025

International workshop on the interplays between intimacies and mobilities, organised by Christiane Reinecke (Seminar für Geschichte) and colleagues

This workshop aims to contribute to the emergent research on the intersecting histories of sexualities and mobilities by shining a light on the various ways in which economies influenced the intimate practices of people on the move. In order to cover a wide range of national, imperial and postcolonial contexts, the workshop brings together international scholars working on different regions and different types of mobilities, like tourism and labour migration. It explores how historical subjects navigated, were shaped by and, in turn, influenced different sexual and mobility regimes. Comparative Perspectives on Taxation and the Colonial State/ Termin: 25.—27.09.25 Internationale Konferenz zu Kolonialfinanzen, organisiert von M. Buggeln und J. Kreutz

How did European colonialism function, and who bore its financial and structural costs? From 25 to 27 September 2025, the international conference *Comparative Perspectives on Taxation and the Colonial State* will take place at Europa-Universität Flensburg (Room TAL 007), aiming to establish a comparative framework on colonial fiscal policy. Topics include taxation, public finance, resistance, and long-term effects of colonial rule. Rat der EU: Weg frei für europäische KI-Strategie in Forschung und Wissenschaft

Council of the EU Sets Framework for a European Strategy on AI in Science

On 23 May 2025, the Council of the European Union adopted conclusions calling for the development of a comprehensive strategy for Artificial Intelligence (AI) in science. The conclusions emphasize the importance of responsible, ethical, and inclusive AI use in research to foster innovation, societal benefit, and competitiveness. Key priorities include interdisciplinary research ecosystems, improved access to AI infrastructure (e.g., AI factories, HPCs), coordinated funding, training initiatives, and support for open science and FAIR data. The Council also backs the creation of a European AI Research Council (RAISE) and calls for harmonisation of national strategies to prevent fragmentation. Since April 2025, Egypt is officially associated with the Horizon Europe Framework Programme. The association agreement enables Egyptian researchers to participate in Horizon Europe calls. The decision was taken despite concerns voiced by several Members of the European Parliament regarding restrictions on academic freedom and freedom of expression in Egypt.
