ICES Call for field research and qualification grants / Deadline: 24.10.2024

ICES (ko-)finanziert Teilnahme an Methodenschulungen, Feldforschungs- und Archivaufenthalte

We welcome proposals from postdocs and doctoral students working in the field of European Studies within this call. We provide grants for researchers in qualification phases at EUF as well as associated ICES members who plan to conduct field research or archive/library stays. In addition, you can apply for funding to participate in European Studies-specific training courses (online or face-to-face). We can fund stays for research or qualification purposes of generally up to 1.200 euros each. They should take place in autumn semester 2024/25 or spring semester 2025. Please provide an application (max. 1 page), including a short description of your research project respectively the training program you plan to attend, the necessity for and details about your intended stay, preliminary timeframe, and a budget plan. Applications can be submitted in German or English. We give priority to ICES Research School members when awarding the grants. Please send it to ices@uni-flensburg.de before 20.11.2024. The call is published every year in May and November.

You can also apply for funding between calls. Applications will then be approved as part of the next call. We look forward to receiving your proposal.

DFG Supports German-Italian Villa Vigoni Talks in November 2025

„Italien und Deutschland im Prozess demokratischer Regression“

The German Research Foundation (DFG) has awarded funding for a conference at Villa Vigoni titled "Italien und Deutschland im Prozess demokratischer Regression." Initiated and academically led by Prof. Dr. Ulrich Glassmann (EUF, Comparative Political Economy) and Prof. Dr. Ubaldo Villani-Lubelli (Università del Salento) the conference will bring together 16 experts. This includes six Early Career Researchers from the participating institutions selected through a call for papers which will be published February 2025. Participants from fields such as Political Economy, History of Political Institutions and

Plural Economics will examine the state of German and Italian democratic institutions, socio-economic challenges, and their joint capacity for action in Europe.

The interdisciplinary exchange will assess each country's resilience to democratic regression and explore bilateral measures to address these trends.

This initiative aims to retain existing academic potential within Ukraine and prevent talent from leaving the country. German universities and research institutions are invited to develop new partnerships with Ukrainian counterparts, especially in interdisciplinary fields within the humanities and social sciences.
