## ICES QUALIFICATION OPPORTUNITIES

A central pillar is the bi-weekly ICES Research Colloquium. It offers all ICES members the opportunity to present their research and to discuss it in an interdisciplinary way. Besides, renowned researchers in the field of European Studies offer regularly colloquia and workshops. Within ICES projects and with our partners, we organize summer/ winter schools and specific trainings.

The affiliation of the European Wasatia Graduate School for Peace and Conflict Resolution offers additional qualification opportunities to understanding the structural nature of conflict and the development of conflict resolution strategies.

## QUALIFICATION PROGRAM FOR EARLY STAGE RESEARCHERS (QP)

Within this program, we support EUF PhD and post-doctoral researchers with free courses on overarching key qualifications in the areas of methodology, self-organization and self-reflection. Developed and organized by ZWW (EUF's Centre for Further Education), it is funded by ZeBUSS, ICES, the Research Committee and the ZWW.

## NETWORKING:

The ICES Research School offers a variety of opportunities for interdisciplinary and cross-institute networking, in particular through regular meetings, colloquia and workshops, as well as with office and meeting facilities. We are also happy to facilitate invitations of guest researchers.

## FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES:

ICES publishes twice per year (May and November) a Call for Field Research Proposals under which ICES Research School Members are invited to apply for funding to realise archival and interview travels. We also support our members in applying for third-party funding - individually and comprehensively from the project idea to the proposal submission.
