Writing Workshop: exploring and interrogating writing as a practice and methodology - Writing into Meaning

Workshopsprache: Englisch

**Inhalt:** This academic writing workshop will run online over a period of two days, with designated time away from the screen. It will be geared towards any postgraduate researcher who is actively engaged in writing at any stage of their studies.

The workshop will explore the coming into being of a writing/writerly space 'with a difference'. It assumes an ambition to move beyond a technical and instrumental approach to the support of academic writing as only ever scientific in order to explore 'writing as a method of inquiry'.

Workshop participants will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of ways that allows for a 'pace' that is both relaxed and engaging and yet also tightly focused. There will be opportunities to listen (exploring theories and ideas of writing; as well as experiences of academic writing); to discuss and reflect (both in small and larger groups) and to write for sustained periods (including giving supportive feedback on others' writing).

All participants are encouraged to bring their own writing to the workshop in whatever language they choose. However, all materials and discussions will be conducted through the medium of English.
